

**Logitech Europe S.A. Compliance with European Union regulation
Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances
(EU REACH - 1907/2006)**

Dear Logitech Consumer,

Logitech supports the requirements placed upon industry to be capable of demonstrating environmental responsibility to customers, legislators, employees, shareholders, investors and environmental groups.

Logitech's Hazardous Substance Management Systems ("HSMS") monitors technology, legislation and environmental management practices to continually minimize the environmental impact of its products and assist in demonstrating our compliance with our environmental responsibilities.

In keeping with this, Logitech supports REACH (Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 for Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restrictions of Chemicals) to further improve the European Union chemicals regulatory system, including the aim of advancing public health and safety and the protection of the environment.

Under REACH, registration is required for applicable substances produced or imported into the European Union ("EU") in quantities over 1 ton per year. Such registration is applicable to substances on their own or in preparations and also in articles if the substance is intentionally released. Since Logitech does not import such substances and our electronic products typically do not intentionally release chemical substances to the environment, this requirement does not currently apply to Logitech or Logitech products.

Furthermore, REACH requires that articles containing Substances of Very High Concern ("SVHC") above a concentration limit of 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) and above a total SVHC mass/volume of 1 ton per year manufactured or imported into the EU must be notified to the European Chemicals Agency ("ECHA"). This is not applicable to Logitech products.

REACH also requires that Logitech provide our customers with sufficient information on SVHC contained in products in concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w). In accordance, with this obligation, the substance(s) listed below may be contained in these named products, above the threshold level of 0.1% by weight of the listed article



All other Logitech products **do not contain SVHC** in excess of 0.1% (w/w) and therefore do not require declaration.

Logitech remains dedicated to ensuring a continued successful implementation of this REACH program and, under our phthalate restriction policy no longer design products which utilize these SVHC substances in excess of 0.1% threshold.
