The European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive (2002/95/EC) and the respective national legislation of the Member States restrict the use of various substances in Electrical and Electronic equipment placed on the European market after 1st July 2006.

Logitech is committed to strict compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, including European Commission guidelines and Member States RoHS legislation and has ensured compliance with RoHS Directive requirements on all Logitech and Labtec products since July 1, 2006.

Logitech established a RoHS Team in 2004 who developed and implemented the Global RoHS Compliance Program, utilizing leading industry techniques in the assessment of component and process compliance to RoHS,

Logitech maintains a system capable of demonstrating single component traceability to RoHS compliance via Declaration of Conformity and other technical documents such as Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) and Chemical Analysis (ICP) test reports. Logitech RoHS sustaining program includes, regular manufacturing, product and supplier audits and maintenance of component substance analysis reports to ensure continued validity.
