



**LOGITECH EUROPE S.A. COMPLIANCE WITH THE WASTE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (WEEE) EUROPEAN DIRECTIVE**

Dear Partner,

The European Union Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Directive (2002/96/EC) and the respective national legislation of the Member States set collection, recycling and recovery targets for Electrical and Electronic Equipment placed on the European Market. The WEEE legislation also makes provisions on information to end users and improvement of product design.

Logitech recognizes its role in environmental and social matters and is committed to strict compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. It is important to us to ensure that Logitech products are recycled in a legal manner with minimal impact to the environment.

In relation to our WEEE activities, Logitech has taken measures to reduce the waste arising from our products and improve their environmental performance and we continue to assess opportunities for further improvement. In some countries, Logitech is registered directly with national WEEE Registry and/or WEEE collective scheme and is taking direct financial and administrative responsibility for WEEE reporting, recovery and recycling of all Logitech and Labtec branded products placed on the relevant national market. In countries where Logitech has no direct responsibility, adequate measures have been put in place to collaborate with distributors that shall comply with the national WEEE legislation.

Logitech is an active member of the European Recycling Platform (ERP) which is a pan-European WEEE compliance scheme setup in 2002 to ensure as cost-effective implementation of the national WEEE schemes administered by ERP. Such a scheme is established for the benefit of participating companies and their customers. All Logitech's distributors may benefit from the ERP services which is the most cost effective WEEE scheme within the countries in which ERP currently operates.

A Logitech WEEE Team has been established to lead our WEEE efforts. It includes representatives from all relevant organisational functions.
