



## LOGITECH EUROPE S.A. COMPLIANCE WITH THE RESTRICTION OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (RoHS<sup>1</sup>) EUROPEAN DIRECTIVE

Dear Partner,

The European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive<sup>1</sup> has been implemented into national legislation of the European Union. According to the European Directive, and in order to remove disparities across the Member States, the national RoHS legislation restricts the use of various substances in electrical and electronic equipment put on the European market after 1st July 2006.


Logitech is committed to strict compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, including European Commission guidelines and Member States RoHS legislation and therefore, Logitech will comply with RoHS Directive requirements on all products from the RoHS deadline of July 1, 2006.


A Logitech RoHS Team has been established, which includes representatives from all relevant organisational functions, to lead our RoHS transition efforts. The RoHS Team has undertaken extensive compliance planning, assessment and implementation work since early 2004 by utilizing industry leading techniques in the assessment of compliance to RoHS by our processes and components.

The result of this is that Logitech now maintains a system capable of demonstrating single component traceability to RoHS compliance via Declaration of Conformity and other technical documents such as Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) and Chemical Analysis (ICP) test reports.

Further, to ensure ongoing product compliance with RoHS into the future, Logitech has implemented a RoHS sustaining program incorporating regular manufacturing, product and supplier audits and maintenance of component substance analysis reports to ensure continued relevance.
