




SETTING UP THE KEYBOARD CASE


Getting started

1 Pull the battery tab away from the keyboard:




Check that the power button is set to "on" and the LED is blinking.

2 Open the keyboard case, insert the top corners of your tablet into the top hooks of the expandable holder:




If the tablet is too big, insert the left corner into the holder first, push it up a bit, then insert the right corner into the holder.

3 Push the whole tablet up and lock the bottom two corners into the holder:



4 Move the keyboard case into the typing position. Push the hooks on the holder into the lifting slots on the keyboard:




The hooks must be inserted into the lifting slots to allow lifting of the whole case.

Establishing connection with your tablet

The keyboard case links to your tablet via a *Bluetooth* connection. The first time you use the keyboard case, you must pair it with your tablet.

The status light blinks blue to indicate that the keyboard is discoverable, ready for pairing with your tablet.



The first time you turn on the keyboard it remains discoverable for 15 minutes.


If the status light turns red, replace the batteries. For more information, see "Replacing the keyboard batteries."

To pair your keyboard case with your tablet:

- 1 On your tablet:
 - Make sure *Bluetooth* is on. Select *Settings* > *Bluetooth* > *On*.
 - Select "Universal Folio" from the *Devices* menu.
- 2 If your tablet requests a PIN, enter it using the keyboard (not on your tablet).
When successful connection is made, the status light turns solid blue for a short time, and then turns off.

Connecting to another tablet

- 1 Move the keyboard case into the typing position.
- 2 On your tablet, make sure *Bluetooth* is on. Select *Settings* > *Bluetooth* > *On*.
- 3 Press the *Bluetooth* connect button for 2 seconds until the status light blinks blue:



The keyboard is discoverable for 3 minutes.

USING THE KEYBOARD CASE

Two viewing positions

Typing position

The keyboard case provides two viewing positions — one for typing and another for browsing.


To type, move the keyboard case into the typing position, inserting the hooks into the lifting slots to secure it:



Check that the keyboard power is on by either checking the power button, the LED or press the Battery Check Hot Key (see Hot Keys). The LED will blink green if the keyboard is powered on.

Browsing position


To browse, place the keyboard case in the browsing position:



The keyboard does not power off automatically. It is recommended that the keyboard power is turned off to conserve battery power.

Detaching your tablet


1 Remove the tablet holder hooks from the slots on the keyboard:



3 Lift the bottom of the tablet and remove it from the upper hooks:




2 Lay the tablet holder flat and push the tablet upwards to release the bottom hooks from the tablet:




Storing your tablet for travel

- 1 Insert your tablet in the tablet holder.
- 2 Close the keyboard case.
- 3 Wrap the elastic strap around the front of the case to keep it from opening accidentally:




Stylus storage

There is a holder on the front of the case to store a stylus, if present. Slide the stylus into the holder to store:



STATUS LIGHT INDICATORS

Your keyboard case's status light provides information about the battery power and Bluetooth connection:




Light	Description
Green	The batteries have adequate charge.
Red	Battery power is low (less than 10%). Replace the batteries.
Blinking blue	Fast: The keyboard is in discovery mode, ready for pairing. Slow: The keyboard is trying to reconnect to your tablet.
Solid blue	Bluetooth pairing or reconnection is successful.



REPLACING THE KEYBOARD BATTERIES



If the status light is red the keyboard case batteries need to be replaced.

- 1 Rotate your keyboard and fold the tablet holder round to the back of the keyboard.
- 2 Using a fingernail or thumbnail, pry open the battery holder from the top of the keyboard.
- 3 Remove the old batteries and insert new batteries.
- 4 Close the battery holder.



Battery information

- A set of new batteries provides about two years of use when the keyboard is used about two hours a day.*
- Replace the batteries if the status light turns red briefly after the keyboard turns on.
- When not in use, turn off the keyboard case to conserve power.
- The keyboard enters sleep mode automatically if not used for a while in the typing position. Press any key to wake it.

* Actual battery life will vary with use, settings, and environmental conditions.



TROUBLESHOOTING


The keyboard does not work

- Press any key to wake the keyboard from sleep mode.
- Turn the keyboard off and then back on.
- Replace the keyboard batteries. For more information, see “Replacing the keyboard batteries.”
- Re-establish the Bluetooth connection between the keyboard and your tablet.
- On your tablet, check that Bluetooth is turned on. (Settings > Bluetooth > On).
- Choose “Universal Folio” from the Devices menu on your tablet. The status light turns solid blue when Bluetooth connection is established.




设置键盘保护套



- 1 从键盘中拉出电池标签:
- 2 打开键盘保护壳, 将平板电脑的上面两个角插入到可伸缩夹中:
- 3 将整个平板电脑上推, 然后将下沿固定到托钩中:
- 4 将键盘保护套抬起到打字位置。将托钩插入键盘上的竖直插口内:



检查电源按钮是否已“开”, 以及 LED 是否闪烁。



如果平板电脑较大, 不易操作, 可先将左上角插入, 向上推一段距离, 然后再插入右上角。




托钩插入后才能将完全抬起到位。

建立与平板电脑之间的连接

键盘保护套与平板电脑之间通过蓝牙进行连接。首次使用键盘保护套时，必须将其与平板电脑进行配对。

状态指示灯闪烁蓝灯，表示键盘处于可被搜索状态，可与平板电脑进行配对。



首次开启键盘后，键盘将保持可被搜索状态 15 分钟。


如果状态指示灯变为红灯，请更换电池。有关详细信息，请参见“更换键盘电池”。

将键盘保护套与平板电脑进行配对：

- 1 在您的平板电脑上：
 - 请确保蓝牙开启。依次选择“设置”>“蓝牙”>“开启”。
 - 在设备菜单中选择“通用保护套”。
- 2 如果平板电脑要求输入 PIN，则使用键盘进行输入（不是在平板电脑上输入）。
成功连接后，状态指示灯将在短时间内变为稳定的蓝光，然后熄灭。

连接到其他平板电脑

- 1 将键盘保护套抬起到打字位置。
- 2 确保平板电脑的蓝牙功能已开启。依次选择“设置”>“蓝牙”>“开启”。
- 3 按住蓝牙连接按钮 2 秒钟，直到状态指示灯闪烁蓝灯：

使用键盘保护套

两种放置方式

打字位置

键盘保护套提供两种位置模式：一种用于打字，一种用于浏览。


若要打字，请将键盘保护套抬起到打字位置，将托钩插入竖直插口来加以固定：



检查键盘电源是否已开启，可查看电源按钮来确定，也可通过LED灯来检查，按下电量检测热键（见热键），如果键盘已通电，LED将闪烁绿色。

浏览位置


如要浏览，请将键盘保护套置于浏览位置：



键盘不会自动关闭。建议在使用完毕后关闭键盘，节省电池电量。

卸下平板电脑

1 将平板电脑托钩从键盘上的插口中拔出：



3 将抬起的平板电脑从上面的夹子中退出。




2 将平板电脑托架平放下来，上推平板电脑，将平板电脑下沿从托钩中取出：




旅行时收纳平板电脑

- 1 将平板电脑插入平板电脑托架。
- 2 合上键盘保护套。
- 3 将弹力带绕过保护套正面，防止意外打开：




触笔位置

状态指示灯

键盘保护套的状态指示灯能为您指示电池电量以及蓝牙连接的相关信息：





指示灯	说明
绿灯	电池电量充足。
红灯	电量不足 (<10%)。更换电池。
闪烁蓝灯	快速： 键盘处于可被搜索状态，已准备好可以进行配对。 缓慢： 键盘正在尝试重新连接平板电脑。
稳定蓝灯	蓝牙配对或重新连接成功。

更换键盘电池



如果状态指示灯变成红灯，则说明键盘保护套的电池需要更换。

- 1 旋转键盘并折叠平板电脑支架，使之转到键盘背面。
- 2 用手指甲或拇指指甲从键盘顶部挑开电池架。
- 3 取出旧电池并插入新电池。
- 4 关闭电池架。

电池信息

- 如果键盘每天使用约两个小时，则新电池组可使用约两年时间。*
- 在开启键盘之后，如果状态指示灯短暂亮起红灯，请更换电池。
- 不使用时，请关闭键盘盖，节省电池电量。
- 在处于输入位置时，如果有一段时间未使用，则键盘会自动进入休眠模式。按任意键即可将其唤醒。

键盘不工作

- 按任意键即可将键盘从休眠模式中唤醒。
- 将键盘关闭，然后再将其重新开启。
- 更换键盘电池。有关详细信息，请参见“更换键盘电池”。
- 在键盘与平板电脑之间重新建立蓝牙连接。
- 确认平板电脑的蓝牙功能处于开启状态。
（“设置”>“蓝牙”>“开启”）。
- 在平板电脑的设备菜单中选择“通用保护套”。蓝牙连接建立后，状态指示灯将变成稳定蓝灯。
