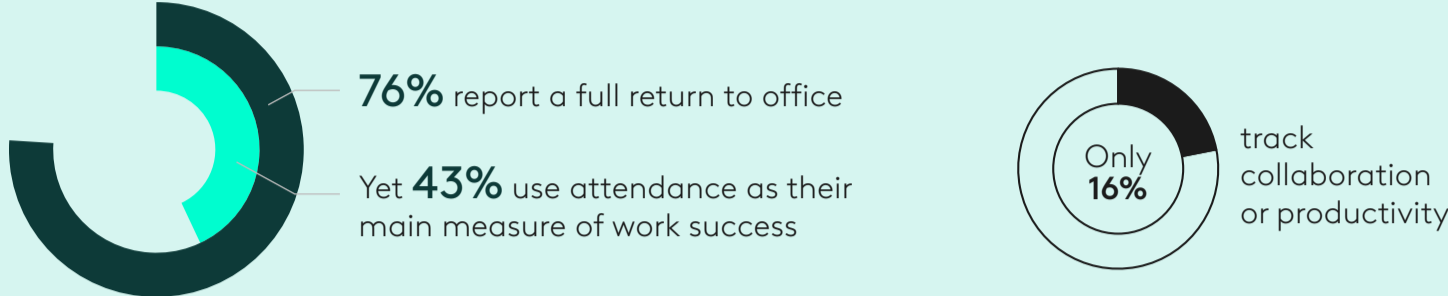
A recent study from GovExec Intelligence, sponsored by Logitech, asked federal leaders how workplace design and technology impact both the employee experience and agency effectiveness.

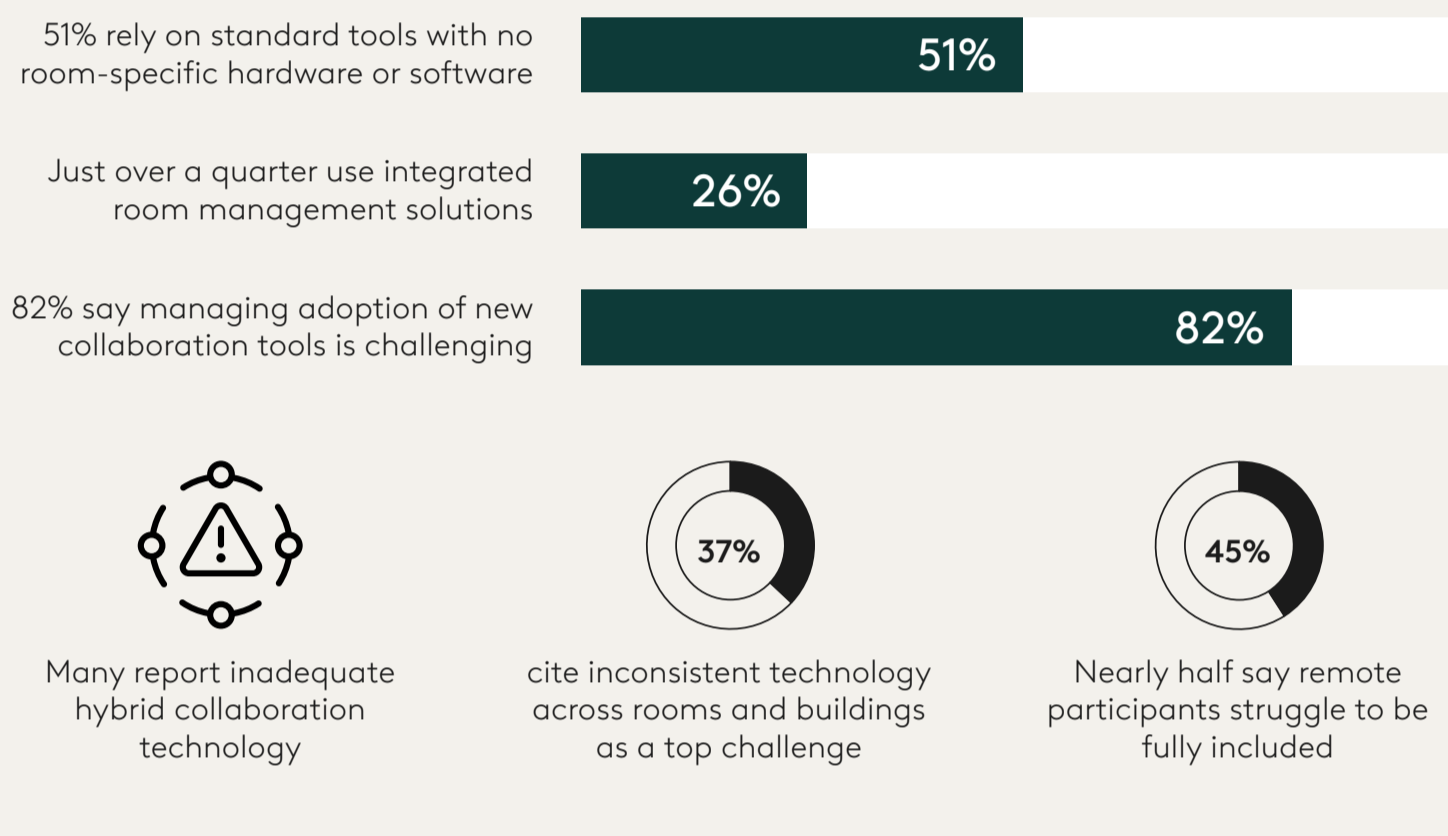
Across the federal government:



Fragmented technology limits collaboration

Government work connects teams, departments and partner organizations, but technology isn't keeping pace. Among all government respondents, 50% report needing frequent IT support to start or join meetings.

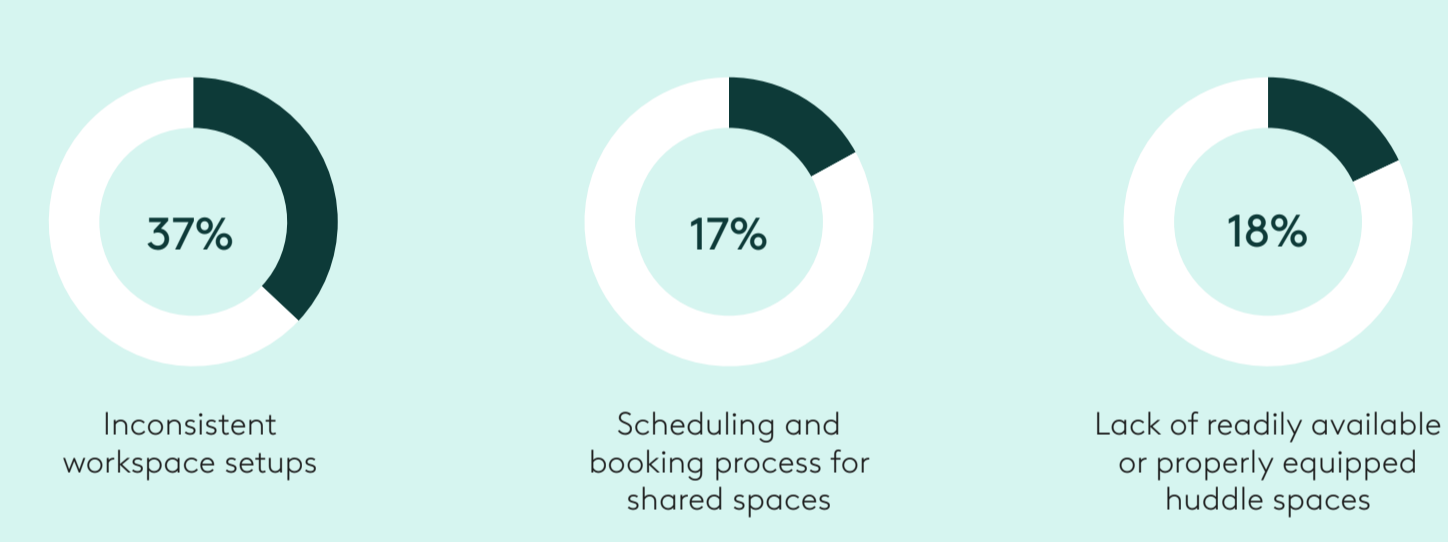
In federal-civilian environments specifically:



Disjointed workspaces add complexity

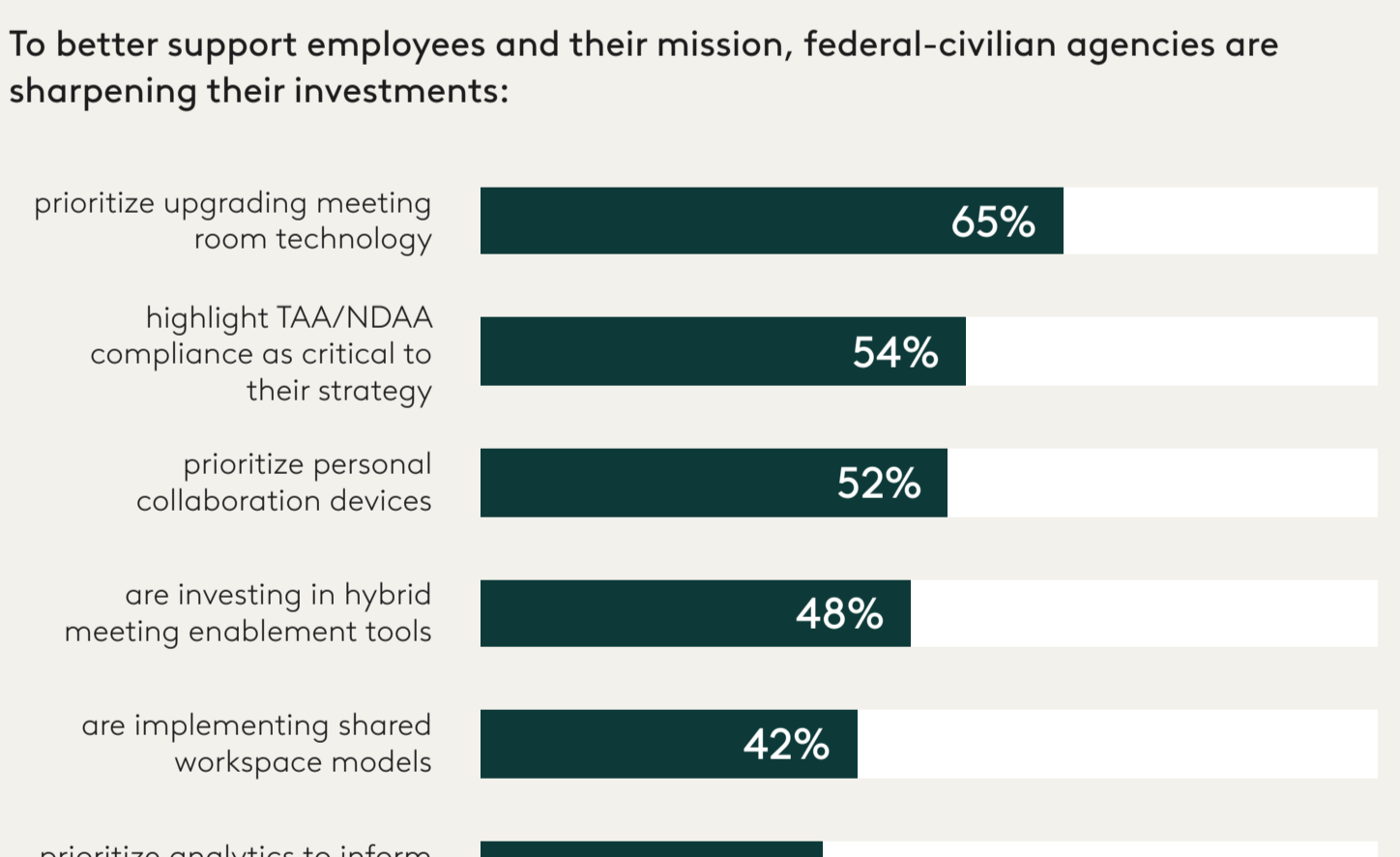
