

(SVIIII) -cued process GG for recalling notes and details

Memory improves when notes are handwitten.

65% of people are visual learners

Combining written notes and drawings deepens classroom experiences 3.

Slows down thinking while fully engaging brain students' neurons fire

Students' neurons fire more activating learning and retention.

Drawing can increase memory by 100% 4.
