

OUR CLIMATE PLEDGE

Human-caused climate change is one of the biggest challenges of our generation. The scale of the change demands collective action.

In FY19, Logitech committed to supporting the goals of the Paris Agreement to help limit global warming to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels. We support international agreements and science-based approaches to support the transition to a 'net-zero' economy, well before 2050 and global efforts to accelerate the transition away from fossil fuel expansion and towards a net-zero economy.

The 2022 report from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) makes it clear that we need to do more to reduce our carbon footprint and do it sooner. We proactively advocate for more progressive climate regulation to support this necessity.

We are formally committed to the Science-Based Targets initiative (SBTi) and our science-based carbon reduction targets have been validated by SBTi ([SBTi Target Dashboard](#)) as follows.

- **85%** absolute reduction in Scope 1 & 2 emissions by 2030, compared to a 2019 baseline
- **100%** renewable electricity in our own operations by 2030.
- **>50%** absolute reduction in Scope 3 emissions across our value chain by 2030, compared to a 2021 baseline.
- **>90%** absolute reduction in Scope 1, 2 & 3 emissions by 2047, compared to a 2019 baseline, with any residual emissions addressed through carbon removals to achieve net zero.

We support an industry-wide shift toward greater carbon transparency and advocate for proactive disclosure of the carbon impact of products. We believe we were among the first consumer electronics companies to introduce carbon impact labels on products and we have now rolled this out across our product portfolio. Through greater transparency, we aim to empower more informed purchasing decisions and encourage broader awareness of product carbon impacts..
