

## Declaration on Mineral Oil Content in Printing Inks

We, Logitech Europe S.A. (EPFL – Quartier de l’Innovation, Daniel Borel Innovation Center, CH-1015 Lausanne, Switzerland), hereby declare that the inks that are used to print our paper packaging conform to the limits established for mineral oil aromatic hydrocarbons (MOAH) and mineral oil saturated hydrocarbons (MOSH) as specified in the French Ministry for Ecological Transition’s Decree of April 13, 2022, specifying the substances contained in mineral oils whose use is prohibited on packaging and for printing intended for the public Official Journal of the French Republic, Number 102, May 3, 2022.

Specifically, the mass concentrations of MOAH and MOSH in the printing inks meets the following thresholds.

Substance	Requirement
MOAH consisting of 1 to 7 aromatic rings	$\leq 0.1\%$ $\leq 1$ ppm for MOAH compounds containing 3 to 7 aromatic rings.
MOSH consisting of 16 to 35 atoms	$\leq 0.1\%$
